

### I. Why does discipleship take place in corporate worship? (1 Cor. 12)

"when you were pagans you were led astray to mute idols"

"To each is given the manifestation of the Spirit for the common good"

Shema: Gifts of the Spirit → service to Christ → effectual working by the Father

"Put simply, 'learning Christ' happens wherever the word and the Spirit of God are at work over time, through people." -Marshall & Payne

"Churches should always be finding ways to go out to their surrounding communities with the gospel (rather than waiting for them to come to us) but we should also conduct our church gatherings in such a way that if and when outsiders do join us, they find the experience a welcoming, accessible and intelligible one that points them to Christ and the gospel. To put it another way: even though the church is the gathering of the saved, because it is a gospelshaped community it will always have a heart for the lost, both in going out into the world and in welcoming enquirers and outsiders into our meetings."
