I. What is the tale Jesus tells? (vv. 1-8)

“A man planted a vineyard ... fence... pit for the winepress... tower.”

“Leased it to tenants and went into another country”

“he sent a servant” → “they beat him & sent him away empty-handed”

“struck on the head & treated shamefully” → “some they beat, and some they killed”

“They will respect my son”

“killed him and threw him out of the vineyard”

II. What is the first plan in the tale? (vv. 9, 11)

verse 1 → Isaiah 5:2

“What will the owner of the vineyard do?”

“He will come and destroy the tenants and give the vineyard to others.”

“Son” (ben) → Psalms 118 “stone” (eben)
