"women looking on from a distance" "followed him and ministered to him" "Joseph of Arimathea ... asked for the body of Jesus" "granted the corpse to Joseph"

- WLC Q. 39: Why was it requisite that the Mediator should be man?
 - <u>Answer:</u> It was requisite that the Mediator be man, that he might advance our nature, perform obedience to the law, suffer and make intercession for us in our nature, have a fellow-feeling of our infirmities; that we might receive the adoption of sons, and have comfort and access with boldness unto the throne of grace.
