I. God loves His children. (vv. 18-23)

"Please let me go back to my brothers in Egypt..."
"Go in peace."
"Go back to Egypt ... the men who were seeking your life are dead."
"But I will harden his heart ... will not let the people go."
"Israel is my firstborn son"
Hosea 11 → Matthew 2

Application: Believe in Christ as the Firstborn who died to make us sons.

SERMON NOTES

II. Shed blood is necessary for pardon & purification.

"the LORD met him and sought to put him to death" "Zipporah ... cut off her son's foreskin" Physical circumcision → circumcision of the heart "Bridgegroom of blood" "... did the signs in the sight of the people. And the people believed." "believed .. had seen their affliction ... and worshiped."

Application: Worship Christ who was cut off to deliver us from sin.
