**I. There is no one like the Lord our God who upholds creation.**

*“that you may know that there is no one like the Lord our God.”*

*“on you and your people and all your servants.”*

*“all the dust of the earth became gnats ... on man and beast”*

*“the land was (being) ruined”*

**Ma’at:** universal equilibrium maintained by \_\_\_\_\_ power.

**Application:** Trust Christ the Creator to uphold creation until the Final Day.

**Psalms 78:45; 105:30-31**

**Colossians 1:16**

*“The plagues dismantle the physical foundations of Egypt and so they explode the religious foundations of Egypt.”*

**II. There is no one like the Lord our God who hears our prayers.**

*“did the same by their secret arts and made frogs come up”: even more frogs!*

*“they could not... “This is the finger of God.”*

*“Plead with the Lord to take away”*

*“Plead for me.”*

**Application:** Plead to Jesus for the benefit of others.

**1 Kings 8:31-40**

**Psalms 8:3**

**Luke 11:14-23**

**III. There is no one like the Lord our God who keeps His Word.**

*"I will let the people go to sacrifice to the Lord"*

*"when Pharaoh saw there was a respite, he hardened his heart and would not listen"*

*"Pharaoh's heart was hardened, and he would not listen to them"*

*"I will set apart the land of Goshen... that you may know that I am ... in the midst"*

*"Go, sacrifice to your God within the land"*

*"Pharaoh hardened his heart ... and did not let the people go."*

**Application:** Trust in God to keep His promise to save you in Jesus.  
Ephesians 2 → Ephesians 1 → Romans. 10

**Proverbs 30:5**

**Romans 10:9-10**
