I. Whole-heartedly love God who is whole-hearted.

"which is the great commandment...?"
"You shall love the Lord your God..."
"The LORD our God, the LORD is one"
Genesis. 2 "one flesh" → Ephesians 5 "Christ and the church"
Deuteronomy "... with all your heart ... soul ... might"
Matthew "all your heart ... soul ... mind"
