I. Love is the essential mark of the Christian. (3:11-15; 4:7-8, 20-21)

"Love your neighbor" → "love one another" "wicked Cain ... murdered his brother" "his own deeds were evil and his brother's righteous." "we have passed out of death into life." "Born of God and knows God"

> Genesis 4:1-10 John 13:35 Hebrews 11:4

II. We can love because God loved us & lives in us. (3:16; 4:8-12, 16, 19)

Cain vs. Christ: "He laid down his life for us" "the propitiation for our sins" "God is love" (4:8,16) → loved us → love one another. "God abides in us and His love is perfected in us" "abides in love abides in God"

Colossians 3:3

"we ought to lay down our lives for the brothers."
John 13: "to love one another as I have loved you."
1 Thessalonians 5
Commitment: To love your fainthearted neighbor with gospel comfort & hope.
"If anyone has the world's goods and sees his brother in need..."
"let us not love in work or talk but in deed and in truth"
"... closes his heart against Him"
Commitment: To love your needy neighbor with the world's good.

John 13:34 Romans 12:15 2 Corinthians 1:3-4 Galatians 6:3 1 Thessalonians 5:14 Jeremiah 2:14-24
