I. God's weak people worship the glorious Warrior. (vv. 1-3, 13, 20-21)

"Moses and the people ... sang this song to the LORD" "my strength and my song → my salvation" "The LORD is a man of war" "in Your steadfast love". "Miriam the prophetess ... took a tambourine ... dancing ... sang"

If Jesus has set you free, joyfully worship Him as glorious Warrior with His people.

II. The LORD is a glorious warrior who fought for us. (vv. 1-12, 16-18)

"triumphed gloriously"
"water piled up ... in a heap ... congealed" "blew with your wind" "earth swallowed"
"thrown into ...cast them into the sea" I "sunk" "down like a stone" "sank like lead"
"glorious in power ... shatters the enemy"
"redeemed" and "purchased"
"your fury ... consumes them like stubble" "Blast of your nostrils"
"Who is like you among the gods?"
"Who is like you, majestic in holiness, awesome in glorious deeds, doing wonders?"
"will bring them in and plant them on your own mountain"

If you trusted Jesus to pardon you, trust Him to finish the job and bring you Home.

III. The glorious Warrior overthrows the proud & powerful.

(vv. 9, 13-16)
