**I. The Covenant Lord keeps His promises. (vv. 1-4)**

*“say ... and explain to the Israelites”*

**Judgment:** *“You have seen what I did to the Egyptians”*

**Salvation:** *“how I carried you on eagles’ wings”*

**Relationship:** *“brought you to myself”*

**Deuteronomy 32:10-11**

**1 Peter 3:18**

**II. The Covenant Lord requires obedience to the covenant. (v. 5)**

*“carefully listen to me and keep my covenant”*

**Obedience** → **Grace**

**Grace** → **Obedience**

In Christ: **Justification** → **Adoption** → **Sanctification** → **Glorification**
