Isaiah 42:6

"I am the Lord; I have called you in righteousness; I will take you by the hand and keep you; I will give you as a covenant for the people, a light for the nations"

Is. 49:6;

"It is too light a thing that you should be my servant to raise up the tribes of Jacob and to bring back the preserved of Israel; I will make you as a light for the nations, that my salvation may reach to the end of the earth."

Odin made man from the ash tree and woman from the elm tree


Odin fashioned Midgard (Middle Earth) for man and Asgard as a home of the gods
