#### Life Thru Union

#### **Love Produces Respect**

- In vs. 33, the command to love is "in \_\_\_\_\_\_ that" she might respect her husband.

What keeps women from expressing respect?

### The Power to Respect

- The \_\_\_\_\_\_ to consistently respect a husband (or anyone else) is beyond us.
- Our culture \_\_\_\_\_ the \_\_\_\_\_ of men, and most women have been taught this.
- Their own \_\_\_\_\_ resists giving respect to another, focusing on their faults.

- Ps 130: God is to be feared because there is forgiveness with Him. A forgiving husband.
- "Reckless forgiveness" is granted to a woman who struggles with & against her own sin.
- Titus 2 indicates that older women are to teach younger women how to live this way.

### **Restoring His Dignity Thru Respect**

- As a husband "nourishes and cherishes" his wife, he \_\_\_\_\_ her dignity.
- She doesn't restore his by nourishing & cherishing him. That is \_\_\_\_\_\_ him!
- Respect is a husband biggest \_\_\_\_\_; it is tied to \_\_\_\_\_ in his primary calling.
- She needs \_\_\_\_\_\_ to fulfill her primary calling to "*fill the earth*."
- Called to "subdue and rule" respect tells us "you're good at what you do": competence.
