#### LESSON 15: GLORIFYING AND ENJOYING GOD IN EFFECTUAL CALLING

Intro:

BIG IDEA: Glorify God for your will so you embrace Christ as He is

### **Question 31: What is effectual calling?**

**Answer:** Effectual calling is the work of God's Spirit, whereby, convincing us of our sin and misery, enlightening our minds in the knowledge of Christ, and renewing our wills, he doth persuade and enable us to embrace Jesus Christ, freely offered to us in the gospel.

#### Question 32: What benefits do they that are effectually called partake of in this life?

**Answer:** They that are effectually called do in this life partake of justification, adoption, and sanctification, and the several benefits which in this life do either accompany or flow from them.

WLC Q. 67. What is effectual calling?

A. Effectual calling is the work of God's almighty power and grace, whereby (out of his free and special love to his elect, and from nothing in them moving him thereunto) he does, in his accepted time, invite and draw them to Jesus, by his Word and Spirit; savingly enlightening their minds, renewing and powerfully determining their wills, so as they (although in themselves dead in sin) are hereby made willing and able freely to answer his call, and to accept and embrace the grace offered and conveyed therein.

WLC Q. 68. Are the elect only effectually called?

A. All the elect, and they only, are effectually called; although others may be, and often are, outwardly called by the ministry of the Word, and have some common operations of the Spirit; who, for their willful neglect and contempt of the grace offered them, being justly left in their unbelief, do never truly come to Jesus Christ.

1. All those whom God hath predestinated unto life, and those only, he is pleased, in his appointed and accepted time, effectually to call, by his Word and Spirit, out of that state of sin and death, in which they are by nature, to grace and salvation, by Jesus Christ; enlightening their minds spiritually and savingly to understand the things of God, taking away their heart of stone, and giving unto them a heart of flesh; renewing their wills, and, by his almighty power, determining them to that which is good, and effectually drawing them to Jesus Christ: yet so, as they come most freely, being made willing by his grace.

Outward Call + Inward & Effectual Call = Salvation

"The liberty of the will is not invaded, for that would destroy its very nature; but its obstinacy is overcome, its perverseness taken away, and the whole soul powerfully, yet sweetly attracted, to the Savior." **Robert Shaw**<sup>136</sup>

2. This effectual call is of God's free and special grace alone, not from anything at all foreseen in man, who is altogether passive therein, until, being quickened and renewed by the Holy Spirit, he is thereby enabled to answer this call, and to embrace the grace offered and conveyed in it.

- God \_\_\_\_\_\_ this to no one. It is of God's free & special \_\_\_\_\_.
- God does not do this in response to anything in us. We are completely \_\_\_\_\_\_.
- Monergism: \_\_\_\_\_\_. In regeneration, only God works & gets glory

"That the sole agent in this effectual calling is the Holy Spirit; that he uses the Gospel truth as his instrument; and that, while all sinners are active in resisting the common influences of grace before regeneration, and all believers in co-operating with sanctifying grace after regeneration

"The only way you can have any affection for Christ is if the Holy Spirit has changed the disposition of your heart and given to you an affection for the One whom you formerly despised. That is where Reformed Theology can be very comforting in giving us assurance." **R.C. Sproul**<sup>139</sup>

Regeneration is an instantaneous, supernatural and radical change in the sinner.<sup>140</sup>

3. Elect infants, dying in infancy, are regenerated, and saved by Christ, through the Spirit, who works when, and where, and how he pleases: so also are all other elect persons who are incapable of being outwardly called by the ministry of the Word.

- The Confession is both \_\_\_\_\_\_ & \_\_\_\_\_ at the same time with "elect infants."

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- God can work \_\_\_\_\_\_ in those who incapable of \_\_\_\_\_\_ faith.

- IOW: Ordinary means for elect people in ordinary \_\_\_\_\_

"If God could create Adam holy without means ... he can certainly make infants and others regenerate without means." **A.A. Hodge**<sup>141</sup>

"Our obligation, as the church, is to be actively engaged in missionary outreach." R.C. Sproul<sup>142</sup>

4. Others, not elected, although they may be called by the ministry of the Word, and may have some common operations of the Spirit, yet they never truly come unto Christ, and therefore cannot be saved: much less can men, not professing the Christian religion, be saved in any other way whatsoever, be they never so diligent to frame their lives according to the light of nature, and the laws of that religion they do profess. And, to assert and maintain that they may, is very pernicious, and to be detested.

- Many hear the \_\_\_\_\_ call of the gospel in church or through a friend or neighbor.

"We are given the commission, as the people of God, as a church, as a ministry, to proclaim the gospel to every living creature, to the whole world. We know that faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God. But not everyone who hears the gospel outwardly responds to it." **R.C. Sproul**<sup>143</sup>

WLC Q. 66. What is that union which the elect have with Christ?

A. The union which the elect have with Christ is the work of God's grace, whereby they are spiritually and mystically, yet really and inseparably, joined to Christ as their head and husband; which is done in their effectual calling.

WLC Q. 69. What is the communion in grace which the members of the invisible church have with Christ?

A The communion in grace which members of the invisible church have with Christ, is their partaking of the virtue of his mediation, in their justification, adoption, sanctification, and whatever else, in this life, manifests their union with him.

"A more complete definition of effectual calling, therefore, might be: that sovereign action of God through his Holy Spirit whereby he enables the hearer of the gospel call to respond to his summons with repentance, faith, and obedience." Anthony Hoekema<sup>145</sup> How does this doctrine help you to glorify and enjoy God?
